

Resolution of _____ County Commission/City Council, State of _____, in support of proposed Federal and State legislation to abolish regional governance and enforce the Federal and State Constitutions.

Whereas, specific legislation has been or soon will be introduced at the Federal and State levels of government. For our United States Congress, the Constitutional Restoration Act, an Act to abolish regional governance and restore constitutional governance within the United States and within every State of the Union. For our State Legislature, a Bill to abolish Regional Governance and enforce the United States Constitution within the State of _____.

Whereas, the Governor's Office and/or the Legislature have divided the State of _____ into multi-county planning districts or sub-regions in which appointed regional councils and agents thereof have seized control. This control, this authority to govern, previously and properly reserved to elected municipal and county officials has been transferred to regional authorities, including authority over land use, zoning and housing, business, private property and thus the people. This control, this authority to govern, has been transferred without the knowledgeable consent of the people of _____ County/City; and

Whereas, the illegal grouping of the State of _____ into Federal region _____ with other sovereign states and subsequent division of the State into sub-regions, governed by regional councils of government, corresponds in function and regulation with the illegal division of the United States into Federal Regions by President Richard M. Nixon. The first illegal presidential act is titled "Statement on Establishing Common Regional Boundaries for Agencies Providing Social and Economic Services" dated March 27, 1969; the second illegal presidential act is Executive Order No. 11647, The Federal Regional Councils, dated February 12, 1972; and

Whereas, many responsible authorities on constitutional law declare the establishment and implementation of Regional Government a violation of United States Constitution, Article IV, Sections 3 and 4 (in part), and the 10th Amendment:

Article IV

Section 3. New States may be admitted by the Congress into this Union; but no new State shall be formed or erected within the Jurisdiction of any other State; nor any State be formed by the Junction of two or more States, or Parts of States, without the Consent of the Legislatures of the States concerned as well as of the Congress.

Section 4. The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government.

Amendment X (1791)

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the states, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the people; and

Whereas, regional governance bypasses our traditional and constitutional government bodies, and usurps the rights and freedoms of individual citizens; rights and freedoms guaranteed by the Constitution of the State of _____ and the Constitution of the United States of America.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE _____ COUNTY COMMISSION/CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are adopted.

SECTION 2: The State Legislature shall create a bi-partisan committee to investigate regional governance, particularly as it usurps the power, jurisdiction, and authority of local governmental bodies, leading to corrective legislation, including but not limited to the State Bill referenced herein.

SECTION 3: A copy of this resolution be forwarded to our State legislature and brought to the attention of every member, also, the legislatures of the other sovereign states in so-called federal region _____, our two United States Senators, and all United States Representatives from our State, requesting support, resolution and/or legislative action.
