EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 117-69

The Lieutenant Governor is hereby designated Chief Executive Officer for Intergovernmental Relations. There is hereby created an Office of Intergovernmental Management, reporting to the Governor through the Lieutenant Governor. The Lieutenant Governor shall utilize OIM as a support to the Cabinet for intergovernmental matters. It is directed and ordered that this Office shall function for the following purposes:

- I. Prepare recommendations to the Cabinet relating to:
 - a. federal departmental regulation and administrative changes,
 - b. federal legislation affecting the State of California, and
 - c. coordination of federal grants-in-aid.

This will prevent inconsistent positions on the part of the State with regard to proposed federal actions and will support the Cabinet system as the primary vehicle for review of the State's problems and assist in the development of criteria for value judgments.

- II. Maintain liaison with individual cities and counties, local government associations and a communications linkage for comments concerning State legislation affecting local government.
- III. Administer the Federal Grant-in-Aid Project No. 373 (OIM).
- IV. Coordinate staffs for several independent activities, obtaining staff coordination for reporting, budget administration, personnel administration, and clerical activities for the Council on Intergovernmental Relations, Environmental Quality Study Council, Model Cities Liaison Group and Intergovernmental Board on Electronic Data Processing. Others may be included in the future by an interagency agreement.

Centralized points of contact for these coordinated activities shall be provided by the Office of Intergovernmental Management; for personnel matters by the Agriculture and Services Agency, with the State Personnel Board; and for budget matters by the Department of Finance.

purposes on intergovernmental matters.
