

TO: Cities, Counties and Councils of Government

Subject: Comprehensive Planning Assistance Proposals 1970-71 Federal Funds (701)

The Council on Intergovernmental Relations herewith announces the Comprehensive Planning Assistance (701) Program for the coming funding period. Preliminary Applications must be submitted to CIR by January 1, 1971.

CIR has established new goals, directions, and priorities for federally funded programs under its jurisdiction in accordance with federal priorities. These new priorities give particular emphasis to intergovernmental action programs. Proposals for funding will be evaluated for creativity and innovation based on the following CIR priority concerns:

Housing elements, the implementation of housing elements of local and areawide plans. (Phase II and III)

Environmental quality, the preparation of local and areawide plans for improvement of the environment with particular emphasis on local and areawide planning for the conservation and management of the coastline.

Local government management, the improvement of the local decision making process through modern budgeting techniques, capital improvement programming and integration of the planning process as a part of the management process

Funding eligibility will be limited to programs of intergovernmental or areawide significance. Single jurisdictions will not be funded unless a proposed program is so creative and innovative that it will benefit jurisdictions throughout the State. Funding for any single proposal will be limited to \$100,000.

With this letter is a preliminary application procedure description, a preliminary application form, and a directory of State and regional or metropolitan clearinghouses.
