## MESSAGE

The 1980 edition of OMB's Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance is now available from the U.S. Government Printing Office for \$20. Local governments and non-profit organizations have found the Catalog to be useful as a basic reference source of Federal programs offering financial assistance (e.g. grants, loans, insurance). The individual program descriptions provide information on objectives and goals of each program, eligible applicants and activities, the application process and Federal contact persons at regional, local and/or headquarters offices. The Catalog is not only organized by the Federal agency sponsoring a particular program but is cross-referenced by functional area as well (e.g., recreation, rural community development, energy conservation, land acquisition).

ABAG member governments and cooperating members may already be familiar with the Catalog through ABAG's free FAPRS service. FAPRS (Federal Assistance Programs Retrieval System), a computerized system which provides rapid access to Federal assistance programs, has been used by some ABAG members to identify available Federal grant programs tailored to the needs of their community.
