Today marks the 123rd anniversary of California's admission as a state in the United States of America. Because of a recent event which took place in New York to make America just one member nation in a world government, perhaps all Californians should become more aware of what it means to live as a Californian and not as a planetary citizen.

How did this stupid belief in humanism get started? Why has it reached the point where the humanists can foster their distorted beliefs on the majority of Americans?

Back in 1939, a group of one-world-minded persons got together and wrote the "Humanist Manifesto No. One" which has been used by our psychiatrists, psychologists and behavioral scientists ever since to change the thinking of all Americans.

Taking God out of our schools stems from this manifesto. So does permissiveness in all behavior and the attempts to legalize marijuana. You name the social changes for the worst since 1939 and you have the working of the first manifesto by these humanists.

In announcing the second manifesto last week in New York, the intellectuals said it was an up-dating of the first manifesto to contain the changes in social behavior since and to include new developments.

It was in 1961 when a book called "The Humanist Frame" was released to the un-

suspecting American public. It was edited by Julian Huxley who wrote the opening chapter and it contains the views of 25 others who go along with the thinking religion has no place in the life of man.

The book parallels the thinking of the second manifesto. In it, Huxley promotes what he calls an "idea-system" which would replace God, the absolutes and all the moral values law-abiding citizens have come to accept as the proper social behavior.

This "idea-system" would become the measuring stick if the humanists have their way. Gone would be the Bible because the "idea-system" replaces biblical promises which the humanists say is harmful to mankind and distracts man from present concerns.

Under the "idea-system", moral values would be derived from human experience and ethics from human needs and interests. In the area of sexuality, laws and social sanctions would be eliminated because they are termed stifling to human expression.

Along with abortion, the humanists want to legalize euthanasia, otherwise known as mercy killing. Their stand is every human has the right to die with dignity. But their manifesto does in no way prevent a large-scale killing spree of the aged at any time they desire.

It doesn't appear to be possible in this day of enlightenment that a segment of our society would make such propositions to do away with all which is true, good and beautiful. But the minds behind one-world government are determined to control the world at all costs.

Model Clubs which operate in our high schools, even high school students began an open campaign to push planetary citizenship. Now you know the source of the doubletalk our students receive.

Yes, this is Admission Day for California. Observe it well and dedicate yourself to questioning everyone, regardless of his stature in life, when he proposes one-world government as the solution to wars and planetary citizenship as the way for better understanding.

These planetary people will tell you God is dead and religion is the enemy of man. Recognize them as the hypocrites Jesus said would appear some day. They are here now pretending to be gods of knowledge, yet they know not the difference between an intelligent man and an intellect.
